edol standard mixing ratio

edol (1<sup>st</sup> agent) 1+1 edol OXY (2<sup>nd</sup> agent)  
 \*At 15 Level... 1+2, LT-EX... 1+3

- edol color number display: e.g., B-3 → B/color tone, 3/brightness
- The bottom section of LT and LT-EX indicates the lifting capacity when dyeing the standard hair.
